

# 2009 Swimming & Diving Policy

## **I. LEAGUE / REGION QUALIFYING**

### ***1. 4A Northern, Sunrise and Sunset Regions***

Competitors must meet the time standard of a particular event in order to qualify for their respective region meet. The events and their time standards, in addition to other meet information relating to qualifying procedures, are outlined in the specific region meet information packets on [www.niaa.com](http://www.niaa.com) (boys/girls swimming & diving).

The meet director(s) will attempt to fill / cap 32 individual entries/ qualifying positions per event according to the time standards. Each team may enter one relay team per relay event for the region meet.

## **II. STATE QUALIFYING**

### ***1. Class 4A***

The top three (3) individuals/relays per event from the Northern Region championship / state qualifying meet, the top two (2) individuals/relays per event from the Sunrise Region championship / state qualifying meet and the top two (2) individuals/relays per event from the Sunset Region championship / state qualifying meet automatically qualify for the state championship meet. The eighth qualifier, out of Southern Nevada, will be determined by comparing times of the third-place finishers from the Sunrise and Sunset region championship / state qualifying meets. Thus, the individual/relay team with the best time (No. 3 finishers only) will advance to the state championship meet as the No. 5 qualifier from Southern Nevada.
